Members of the media are invited to attend a press conference and prayer vigil scheduled for tomorrow morning in Muskowekwan First Nation, Saskatchewan, Treaty 4 Territory. This event will be held at the grounds of the former Muskowekwan Indian Residential School, one of the last residential schools to close its doors in Canada in 1997 and the last fully intact residential school still standing in Saskatchewan. This event will also be a prayer vigil to honour the 215 children found at the Kamloops Indian Residential School and for the children buried on the grounds of Muskowekwan and other residential schools in Canada. Media wishing to attend are requested to RSVP with FSIN Communications as soon as possible. Due to the current pandemic, strict safety and health protocols will be enforced. Please arrive early to allow for check-in.
